High data quality is a hallmark of the register! Therefore in general:

- 1. Please always complete the PROs and fill them out for the appropriate visit. After that, please send the sheets via mail or post to Munich for the double data entry.
- 2. If you are not able to upload DICOM images, we can do that for you. Please send us the images via CD.
- 3. We need EDTA and Tempus blood from every patient and their parents. Moreover we need stained slides or wax block, if a lung biopsy was done.
- 4. Please note, that we primarily want to collect prospective data. Therefore the follow up data is the most important point to analyse this "real time" information.

Observational trial - News II

PROs: Patient Reported Outcomes (= Health economics and Quality of Life (QOL)): Changes to make it more convenient:

- QoL added to all visits
- One questionnaire for all patients
- Only difference: incident cases fill in the questionnaire also after 3 months (Table 1)

Remember:

- Incident cases = patients with newly diagnosed diseases, presenting to the referring center
- Prevalent cases = patients with already diagnosed disease, known to the referring center
