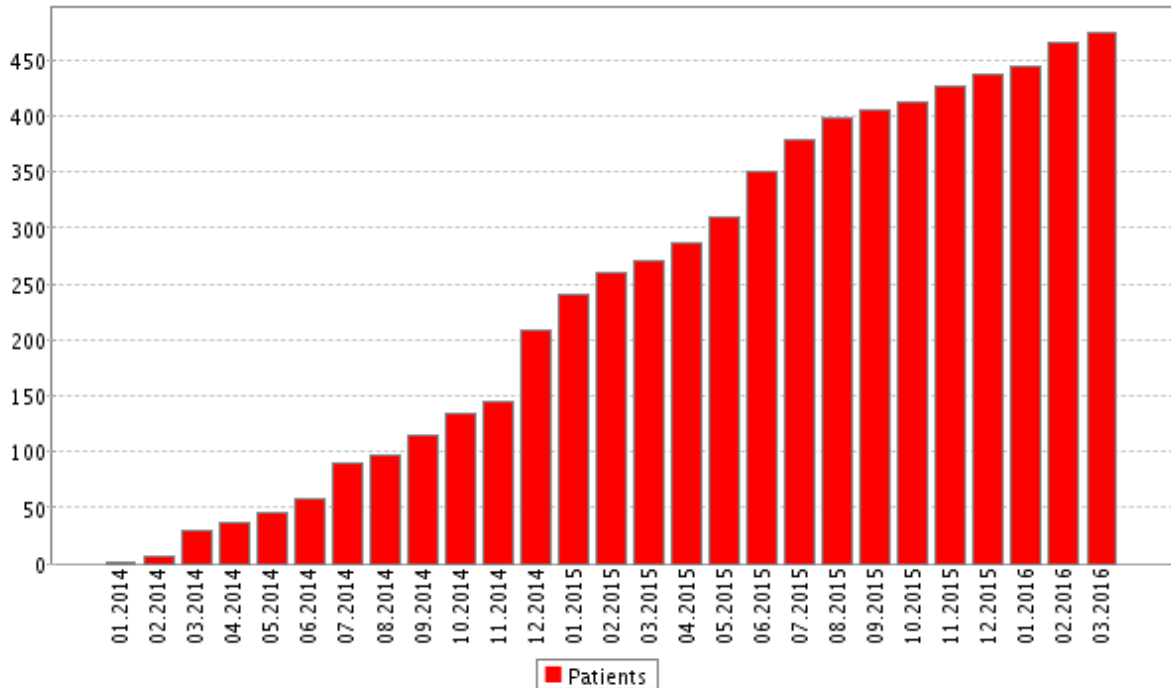




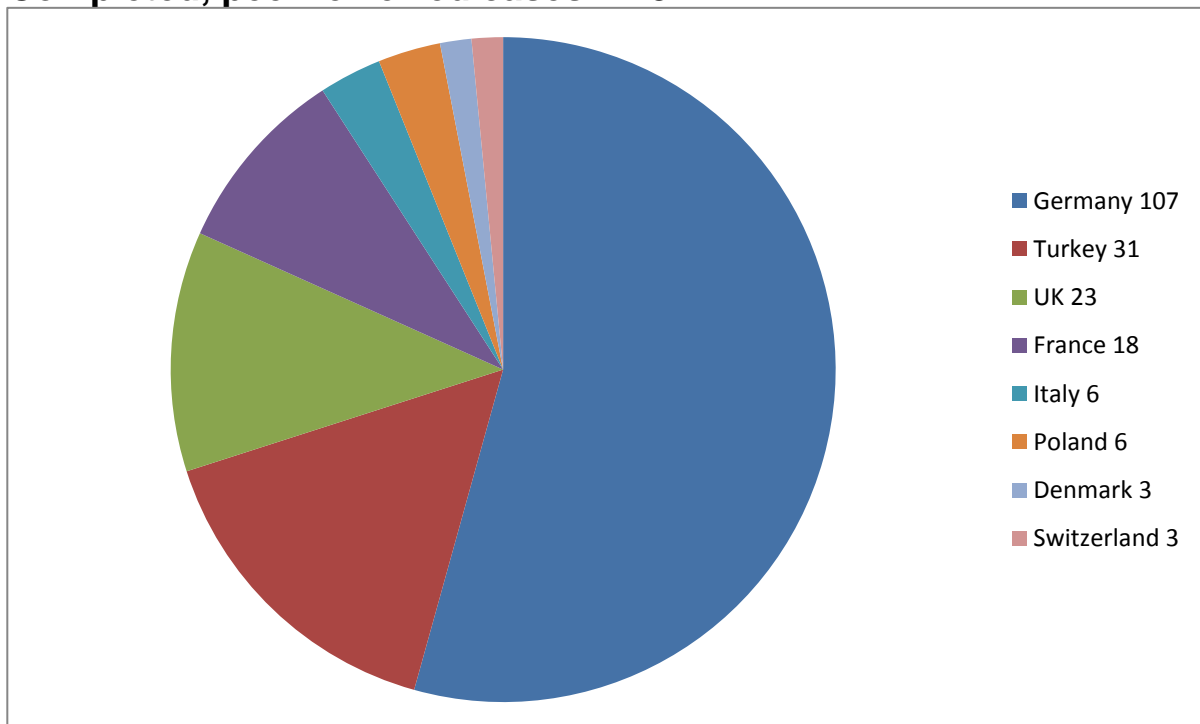

Observational trial

High data quality is a hallmark of the register! Therefore in general:

1. Please **always complete the PROs** and fill them out for the appropriate visit. After that, please send the sheets via mail or post to Munich for the double data entry.
2. If you are not able to **upload DICOM images**, we can do that for you. Please send us the images via CD.
3. We need **EDTA and Tempus blood from every patient and their parents**. Moreover we need the slides, if a lung biopsy was done.
4. Additional samples: **frozen tissue, tissue in RNA later, serum, plasma, fibroblasts**, etc will all be stored for future cohorts; so do not hesitate to collect and ship!
5. Please note, that we only want to collect **prospective data**. Therefore the follow up data is the most important point to analyse this “real time” information.
