The first block includes a workshop on assessment of balance deficits and a workshop on diagnosis and therapy of benign paroxysmal positional vertigo (BPPV, liberatory maneuvers). The second block contains a hands-on workshop on vestibular rehabilitation in acute and chronic balance disorders. The focus will be on practical aspects and relevant background. The courses are designed for the needs of physiotherapists, but other professions interested in the topic are also welcome.
