Typical video examples of patients with different types of vertigo
- ▶ **How to examine the ocular motor system - a hands-on course**  
Anatomy and physiology of the vestibulo-ocular reflex; neuroophthalmologic and neuroorthoptic examination with tests of otolith function (subjective visual vertical and identification of SVV using the bucket test, ocular torsion); differentiation of peripheral and central vestibular lesions
- ▶ **Neuroophthalmology - a hands-on course**  
Different peripheral and central oculomotor and vestibular syndromes and forms of nystagmus
- ▶ **VOG**  
Videoculography and measurements of eye movements and practicing the video head-impulse test.
- ▶ **VEMP**  
Diagnostics with vestibular evoked myogenic potentials (VEMP) to test utricular and saccular function.
- ▶ **Psychotherapy of functional dizziness**  
This course provides an overview of psychotherapy approaches and their efficacy in the treatment of functional dizziness.

### Practical Vestibular Rehabilitation for Physiotherapists

The structured program consists of 3 practical courses. The first block includes a workshop on assessment of balance deficits and a workshop on diagnosis and therapy of benign paroxysmal positional vertigo (BPPV, liberatory maneuvers). The second block contains a hands-on workshop on vestibular rehabilitation in acute and chronic balance disorders. The focus will be on practical aspects and relevant background. The courses are designed for the needs of physiotherapists, but other professions interested in the topic are also welcome.
