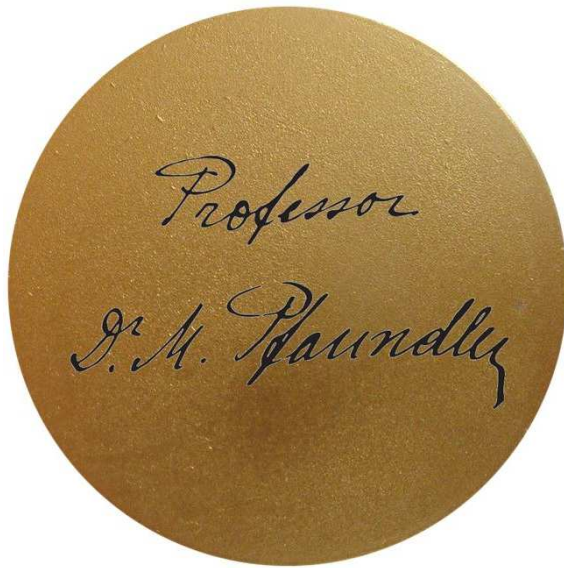


## Standing on the Shoulders of Giants:
