Applications are invited for a postdoctoral to work with Professor Martin Reincke at the Endocrine Research Labs of the Medical Department IV/ University of Munich on a project funded by the ERC. The core aim of the Pathophysiology of Primary Aldosteronism (PAPA) ERC Advanced Grant is to study the humoral and molecular mechanisms underlying aldosterone excess in primary aldosteronism, with a view to identifying novel therapeutic targets. In addition to joining the PAPA group, the successful candidate will join a vibrant research department with a strong engagement in endocrinology and diabetes research.
