We received a lot of very positive feedback, in particular for the hands-on format of the meeting.

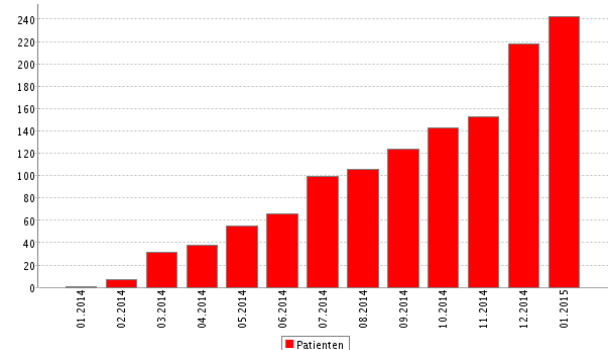

Project: Natural history

Cohort of alive subjects with surfactant dysfunction disorders and related diseases -

Include all patients with SFTPC, ABCA3, TTF1, SFTPB (non-lethal), GMCSFRA/B, lung histology pattern: NSIP, DIP, LIP, PAP, CPI, other/mixed

New Project: Alveolar capillary dysplasia and related conditions

It was decided at the Munich meeting to prospectively study all cases of the chILD group "developmental disorders" at the clinical, pathological and genetic level. Olivier Dainhaive will supply a detailed protocol later.
