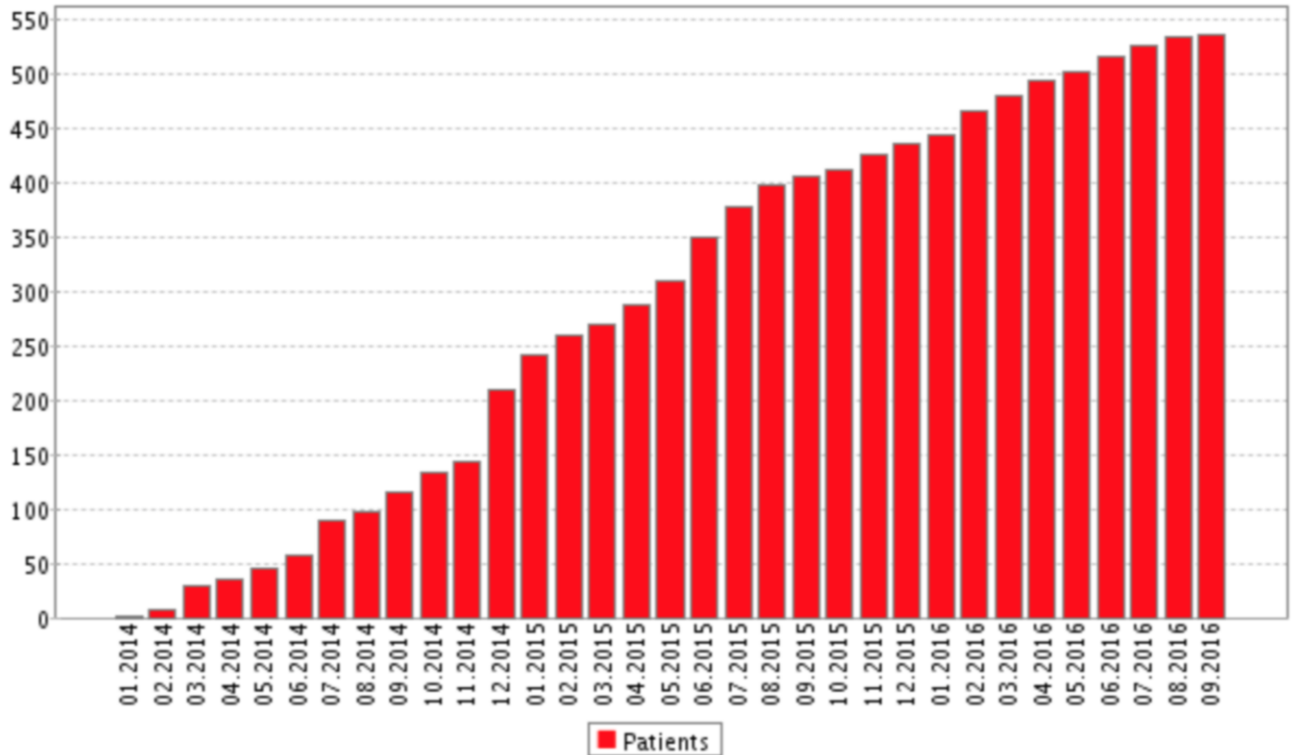




Observational trial

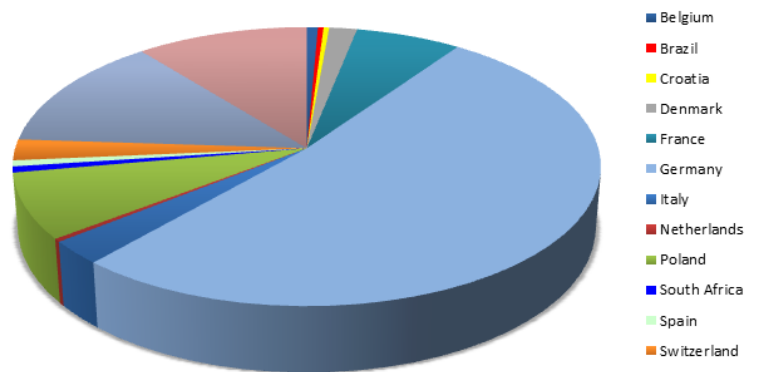
Due to extended summer holidays there were no newsletters from June to August
